Class 1 - 13:50 - Main Ring - National 1.30m Open

Rule 306. Table A9. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m. **DRAWN ORDER**

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members.

Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify.

Prizes: 1st: £200.00, 2nd: £175.00, 3rd: £125.00, 4th: £75.00, 5th: £50.00, 6th: £30.00, Total: £655.00. **Entry Fee = £30.00**

Class 2 - 14:35 - Main Ring - National Accumulator

Rule 274. Table A. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.25m. **DRAWN ORDER**

The order of starting must be drawn.

This competition takes place over six, eight or 10 obstacles which are progressively more difficult. No combination obstacles are allowed. The progressive difficulty is not solely due to the height and spread of the obstacles, but also to the difficulty of the track.

Points are awarded as follows:

One point for obstacle No. 1 cleared, two points for No. 2, three points for No. 3 etc. with total of 21, 36 or 55 points.

No point is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Faults other than knock-downs are penalised as for Table A and any of these faults, including time faults, are converted into points and deducted from any jumping points scored.

In the event of equality of points for first place, there will be a jump-off against the clock over a shortened course, over obstacles that may be increased in height and/or spread. The obstacles in the jump-off must be jumped in the same order as in the first round and retain their respective points allotted in the first round.

This competition may also take place directly against the clock.

For the last obstacle of the course, an alternative obstacle may be provided, of which one part may be designated the Joker. The Joker must be more difficult

than the alternative obstacle and carry double points. If the Joker is knocked down, the points must be deducted from the total.

Prizes: 1st: £125.00, 2nd: £90.00, 3rd: £65.00, 4th: £40.00, 5th: £35.00, 6th: £25.00, Total: £380.00. **Entry Fee = £25.00**

Class 3 - 16:30 - Main Ring - Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round

Rule 310. Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m. **DRAWN ORDER**

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2010, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Qualifies for: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior Foxhunter First Round competitions in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money. Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round Foxhunter competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £80.00, 2nd: £60.00, 3rd: £40.00, 4th: £35.00, 5th: £25.00, 6th: £20.00, Total: £260.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 4 - 17:30 - Main Ring - Blue Chip Pony Newcomers/Pony 1.00m Open (both to inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Qualifier)

Rule 406 & 416. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m. **DRAWN ORDER**

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

Blue Chip Pony Newcomers is for registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. First Rosette in the Pony Newcomers section sponsored by Blue Chip.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final.

Ponies may compete in one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £10.00, Total: £88.00. **Entry Fee = £10.00**

Class 5 - 18:20 - Main Ring - Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted

Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m. **DRAWN ORDER**

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £10.00, Total: £88.00. **Entry Fee = £10.00**
