Class 1 - 09:30 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - Cats & Pipes Debut UK Championship Handicap Qualifier

Rule 414. Table A6. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 75cm / 85cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered ponies not exceeding 138cm, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with rule 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all, however for qualification purposes, those riders up to the end of the calendar year in which the age of 10 is reached are eligible to enter irrespective of Points achieved. Riders aged 10 years and over on 1st January in the calendar year, must not have won a total of 350 points in the 128cm section and 700 points in the 138cm section.

Once riders have competed at, or "ever" qualified for RIHS or HOYS on any height pony they are no longer eligible to compete in the Final. Once a Pony has qualified with any rider for RIHS or HOYS in the current year, then it is not eligible to compete in this competition or the Final.

Qualifying period: 1st January - 31st July

Number to qualify: Two Double Clears.

FOR THE STAR IN THE MAKING SERIES - this section is for registered ponies ridden by a Junior member not to have been on the Gold or Silver league since January 1st 2016. All double clears qualify for the STAR IN THE MAKING GRAND FINAL March 17th-18th CHAMPIONS WEEKEND at REC ARENAS.

All 11 years and under double clears will have dual qualification for the 11 and Under Grand Final.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered ponies not exceeding 128cms, to be ridden by Junior Members born in or after 2006 and registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members born in or after 2004. Pony/Riders are not eligible to compete in this class before the calendar year of which their eighth birthday is reached.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

British Novice:

For registered ponies in Grade JD and JC that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

80cm Open:

For registered ponies to be ridden by Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £91.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 5 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - Graeme Ash Ltd 90cm Novice Masters UK Supreme Championship Qualifier

Rule 406. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered ponies that have not won a total of 300 Points, to be ridden by Pony Members, riders ages competing on 128/138cms ponies must be in accordance with rules 77.12/77.13.

Numbers to qualify: One double clear. Dual qualification for the Pony Discovery.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Blue Chip Pony Newcomers is for registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination.

Ponies may compete in one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £91.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 7 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - Direct Insurance Group PLC Bright Star Championship

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered ponies exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms irrespective of points, to be ridden by Junior Members, disregarding those riders on the 148cms Gold League List as of March 31st 2017 or any rider/pony combination having ever qualified for RIHS or HOYS on a 148cms.

Numbers to qualify: - One double clear

This class can be run with a 148cms Open section, with two sets of prize money awarded, ponies can only enter one section only.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £91.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 9 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - **Junior 1.15m & 1.25m Open Handicap**

Rule 284. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.15m / 1.25m.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Class 1a - 11:00 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - **KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice - First Round**

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by KBIS Insurance Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

British Novice:

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6

Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round.

Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £91.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 2 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery - First Round

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2013 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £91.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 4 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2012, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Qualifies for: Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round.

Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers First Round competitions in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in a Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). To obtain a double clear qualification, even if the horse is the only clear round, it must jump a jump-off round and jump clear to gain a double clear round.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £20.00, Total: £125.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 5 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - Senior 1.10m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £20.00, Total: £125.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00**

Class 6 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/1.20m Open

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Foxhunter section:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2011, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship.

Open section:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £17.00**

Class 7 - INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP ARENA - National 1.30m Open

Rule 306. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members.

Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

Prizes: 1st: £100.00, 2nd: £70.00, 3rd: £60.00, 4th: £45.00, 5th: £25.00, Total: £300.00. **Entry Fee = £21.00**
